If you are interested in participating as a vendor, please note the following Terms of Acceptance for New and Returning Vendors. Thank you and hope to see you there!

TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE FOR VENDORS:

No application will be considered for review without the following:

- (1.) 2026 Vendor Application
 - (2.) Copies for Food Handlers Cards for all workers (Food Booths Only)
 - (3.) If you have General Liability Insurance for your booth, please submit a copy of your insurance certificate with your application.
 - (4.) Full payment. Only money orders, cashier checks or cash will be accepted – NO EXCEPTIONS. Make payment to: **Morongo Band of Mission Indians**. Fees are non-refundable upon acceptance.
 - (5.) **Food Vendors will provide their own Class B or K FIRE EXTINGUISHER suitable for grease and oil fires.**
 - (6.) Vendors must include a detailed list of merchandise or services to be sold or displayed with application. First-time vendors must include photographs of merchandise and booth (Photos will be kept on file and not returned). Incomplete applications will not be considered or returned.
- Submission of fee and application is neither an offer nor a guarantee of space. Application is subject to approval of the Rodeo Committee.
 - Vendor spaces are limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Vendors are permitted ONE SPACE ONLY per booth fee (No Exceptions). No sharing or subletting of spaces is permitted. Booths are to be occupied by the registered vendor only.
 - Deadline for registration and payment in full is Wednesday, Sept 23, at 5:00pm or until all spaces are filled. Late or on-site applications will not be accepted.
 - Vendors will receive notification of acceptance or rejection following receipt and review of complete application.
 - WIND AND RAIN POLICY: This is considered a RAIN, WIND, or SHINE event. No refunds will be given due to inclement weather. Please be prepared for high winds or any inclement weather. Vendor booths are REQUIRED to either be staked down or be weighted down properly.

SET-UP:

- Vendors may set up Saturday, October 3rd from 7:00am to 10:00am. Any vendor not setting up during these times could be subject to forfeiture of their space and application fee will not be refunded.
- Vendors must supply their own canopies, tables, chairs, and generators. Vendors are assigned a 10' x 10' space for their booth only. Vehicles, Trailers, and RV's are not permitted to park next to booths, only in designated areas.

OTHER:

- Vendors will not provide Morongo Indian Cowboy Ranch Rodeo organizers with false or misleading information regarding their business, products, or services.
- The use of alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind will not be tolerated and are cause for cancellation of any contract and removal from the event grounds.
- Parking is free. Overnight camping and parking for Vehicles, Trailers, and RV's is available in designated areas.
- The grounds will be patrolled by Security 24 hours during the event.
- The Morongo Band of Mission Indians, its Organizers, and Rodeo Staff are not responsible for any losses or damages resulting from Acts of God (such as earthquakes, floods, etc.), failure of vendor to abide by the Rules and Regulations, accidents, fire, theft, disputes, inclement weather, or other acts of nature.
