

THE RODNEY T. MATHEWS, JR. MEMORIAL ACADEMIC & VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR MORONGO TRIBAL MEMBERS AND NON-ENROLLED CHILDREN OF TRIBAL MEMBERS

Purpose:

The Rodney T. Mathews, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Program has been established to assist Tribal Members and non-enrolled children of Tribal Members with the pursuit of their education through the granting of financial scholarships. Scholarships shall be awarded to eligible applicants every year if funds are available.

Tribal members are eligible for one (1) bachelor's degree, one (1) master's degree, and one (1) Doctoral degree, and one (1) Vocational Program, subject to Scholarship Fund budget limitations. Continuing Tribal member students do not need to re-apply each year. The application must be updated when starting a new program.

The Rodney T. Mathews, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Program for Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members shall not exceed \$50,000 in total funding for academic applicants and \$10,000 in total funding for vocational applicants provided they stay in the same course of study, subject to Scholarship Fund budget limitations. Continuing Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members may re-apply each year until they have reached total funding.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be enrolled member of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians to receive Tribal Member funding of education OR applicant's Parent(s) must be a registered member of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians to receive descendent funding of education.
- 2. For an academic scholarship, the applicant must be a full or part-time student at an accredited College or University. For a vocational scholarship, the applicant must be a full or part-time student at a Vocational school.
- 3. Must have completed *The Rodney T. Mathews, Jr. Memorial* Scholarship Application and be in good standing with the Morongo Education Services Administrator by the Morongo Scholarship Rules and Regulations.
- 4. Non-enrolled children of Tribal Members must have completed and signed documentation of 60 hours of community service (preferably within a Native community and Native-based agency, etc.) * First-time applicants only.
- 5. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for all undergraduate students and vocational students and a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for all graduate students.
- 6. Academic scholarship applicants must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have financial needs as determined by the Office of Financial Aid.
- 7. Descendant vocational scholarship applicants must not have exhausted the allotted \$10,000 for vocational training and education.
- 8. Descendant children of Tribal members must re-apply each year. New students must have a letter of acceptance from the applicable schools.

Application Procedures:

An applicant may request an application packet at any time. Applications will be available through the Education Services office at 11952 Potrero Road, Banning, CA 92220. You may request that an application be mailed to you, or you may pick up an application directly from Education Services.

The Rodney T. Mathews, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Program Application consists of the following:

- **The application** (see attached). Please answer all questions, sign, and return to Education Services at 11952 Potrero Road, Banning, CA 92220.
- Academic Study Plan (see attached). This form must be completed and signed by your institutional academic advisor for all academic scholarships.
- Vocational Education Study Plan (see attached). This form must be completed and signed by your institutional vocational advisor.
- **Transcripts** Official copies of student transcripts from all colleges and universities previously attended. See the release waiver section in the Terms and Conditions form.
- Essay Questions (For Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members Only)
- Terms and Conditions Form
- The Rodney T. Mathews, Jr. Memorial Academic Scholarship for Non-enrolled children of Tribal members program Rules and Regulations and Morongo Vocational Scholarship Rules and Regulations.

The applicant is responsible for ensuring that their application is complete.

Academic or Vocational Scholarship, agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Students must be enrolled in a degree-seeking program at an accredited university or a vocational program.
- 2. At the end of the Fall semester, the *Education Services Administrator* will review official copies of academic and vocational grade reports. Grade reports will be used to determine student's continued eligibility (units completed and CGPA). <u>It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all grades have been posted and are accurate.</u>
- 3. Keep the *Morongo Education Services Administrator* informed of any changes in student status, i.e., change of address or name, intention to withdraw or transfer, reduction in full-time enrollment, etc.
- 4. Undergraduate recipients must complete each term at a minimum of 6 credit hours. Graduate student recipients must complete each term at a minimum of 3 credit hours. This requirement must be met with new hours only; no-repeat classes will be allowed as part of a full-time course load. Vocational students must complete each term at a minimum of part-time credit hours.
- 5. The following classes will not be accepted as part of a full-time course load: Audits, Repeats, or Workshops. Students may take no more than three credit hours of special study courses per semester as part of their full-time course load.
- 6. Recipients must maintain a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) in a degree-seeking program to be eligible for continuation of funding:
 - Undergraduates/Vocational Students—2.0 CGPA
 - Graduates—3.0 CGPA
- 7. Students must be enrolled in a degree-seeking program at an accredited university or a vocational program.
- 8. At the end of the Fall semester, the *Education Services Administrator* will review official copies of academic and vocational grade reports. Grade reports will be used to determine the student's continued eligibility (units completed and CGPA). It is the student's responsibility to ensure that all grades have been posted and are accurate.
- 9. Keep the *Morongo Education Services Administrator* informed of any changes in student status, i.e., change of address or name, intention to withdraw or transfer, reduction in full-time enrollment, etc.
- 10. Undergraduate recipients must complete each term at a minimum of 6 credit hours. Graduate student recipients must complete each term at a minimum of 3 credit hours. This requirement must be met with new hours only; no repeat classes will be allowed as part of a full-time course load. Vocational students must complete each term at a minimum of part-time credit hours.
- 11. The following classes will not be accepted as part of a full-time course load: Audits, Repeats, or Workshops. Students may take no more than three credit hours of special study courses per semester as part of their full-time course load.
- 12. Recipients must maintain a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) in a degree-seeking program to be eligible for continuation of funding:

- Undergraduates/Vocational Students—2.0 CGPA
- Graduates—3.0 CGPA
- 13. Suspension: Failure to maintain the minimum CGPA or part-time course load will automatically require suspension of scholarship funds. If placed on scholarship suspension, the student's spring award will be automatically canceled. Before re-applying for the *Morongo Scholarship for Tribal Members and Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members*, the student must have completed the number of units for which they received funding and/or have met the minimum CGPA for which they receive funding. Failure to do so will render the student ineligible for future *Morongo Scholarship* consideration.
- 14. Undergraduate Students will only be eligible to receive *Morongo Academic Scholarship for Tribal Members* and *Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members* funding for a maximum of 130-unit hours. Graduate Students will only be eligible to receive *Morongo Academic Scholarship for Tribal Members and Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members* funding for a maximum of 60 unit hours. Funding for *Non-Enrolled Children of Tribal Members* shall not exceed the total sum of \$50,000 total. *Non-enrolled children of Tribal Members* will only be eligible to receive *Morongo Vocational Scholarship* funding for a maximum of \$20,000 total. All vocational funding must be used in one related field of study.
- 15. Applicant agrees to have their name, degree being pursued, and graduation announcement included in any press releases by the Morongo Band of Mission Indians.
- 16. All applicant files are the property of the Morongo Band of Mission Indians.
- 17. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that Education Services receive all required materials. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed; however, a request will be made for the missing/incomplete areas of the application. Applications will not be approved until all required documents are submitted.
- 18. All Morongo Academic Scholarship decisions are final.
